Check-In

Doors Open: 6:50pm

Check-In Time: 7:00pm – 7:30pm

- Groups arriving early must wait to enter the Museum until the doors open
- Groups may check-in once all group members have arrived

When you check-in, you will need to share:

- The number of scouts and adults attending the Camp-In
- Any special needs

At check-in, you will receive:

- Event schedule
- Workshop, snack & breakfast schedules
- Sleeping arrangements
- Evaluation form
- Badge earned (if applicable) & Museum patches

Building locked & alarmed at 7:30pm

Food

- Eat dinner before arriving!
- The Museum provides an evening snack & breakfast
- Groups may not bring their own food, candy, or drinks

Sleeping Arrangements

Groups will be given an assigned campsite area at check-in

Camp-In Rules & Guidelines

- Chaperones must accompany and supervise their group at all times
- Groups may not bring their own food
- Shoes must be worn at all times
- Smoking is not permitted
- Campers are responsible for cleaning their “campsite” area
- The Museum is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- After 7:30pm, Museum doors are locked and alarmed
- Camp-In participation is limited to the groups identified in the brochure— No siblings allowed

Packing List

All gear is limited to the size of one garbage bag per camper

- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Brush/comb
- Comfortable shoes
- Sleeping mat. You may bring a camp bed or an air mattress as long as the mattress can be inflated without the use of an outlet
- Dress in layers—Museum temperature varies
- Wear the clothes you will sleep in
- Optional: spending money for the Hands-On Store

Do Not Bring

- Flashlights
- Any electrical device (example: hair dryer, curling iron, electronic games, radios, electric pump, etc)
- Food (example: candy, snacks, drinks, etc.)

Event Schedule* - Friday pm

- 7:00** Arrive at Museum
- Drop off campers, at least one adult & gear at the Museum
 - Museum parking and curb cut-out are unloading zones only
 - Please be patient during drop-off, other groups will be arriving at the same time
 - Park your car (see parking map)
 - Group leader checks-in group
 - Put gear into “gear storage” for evening
 - Free exploration until Welcome Show
- 7:30** Welcome Show
- 7:45** Workshop 1
- 8:30** Workshop 2
- 9:15** Workshop 3
- 10:00** Evening Meeting
- 10:15** Snack rotation & free time begins
- 11:30** Set-up campsite
- Midnight** Lights out

Event Schedule* - Saturday am

- 7:00** Rise & shine
- 7:15** Breakfast rotation begins
- Pack up gear
- 8 – 8:30** Gift Shop open
- Drop-off evaluations & depart†

* All times are approximate and may change.

† Groups may continue to explore the Museum after 8:30am, but all gear must be out of the building.

DRIVING AND PARKING GUIDE

From the NorthWest

- Take I-96 East to us-23 South to m-14 West
- Exit at Downtown Ann Arbor (Exit #3)
- You will be heading south on North Main Street
- The 5th traffic light is Ann Street
- Turn left onto Ann Street
- The Museum entrance is on the right, between Fourth Avenue & Fifth Avenue

From the West

- Take I-94 East to Jackson Road (Exit #172)
- Take Jackson Road east for 2.5 miles (Jackson Road becomes Huron Street)
- The 1st traffic light after Main Street is Fourth Avenue
- Turn left on Fourth Avenue
- Go 1 block to Ann Street and turn right
- The Museum entrance is on the right, between Fourth Avenue & Fifth Avenue

From the South & SouthEast

- Take I-94 West to Ann Arbor-Saline Road (Exit #175)
- Turn right onto Ann Arbor-Saline Road, which becomes Main Street as you near the downtown area
- Go through downtown to Ann Street (the 1st street after Huron Street)
- Turn right onto Ann Street
- The Museum entrance is on the right, between Fourth Avenue & Fifth Avenue

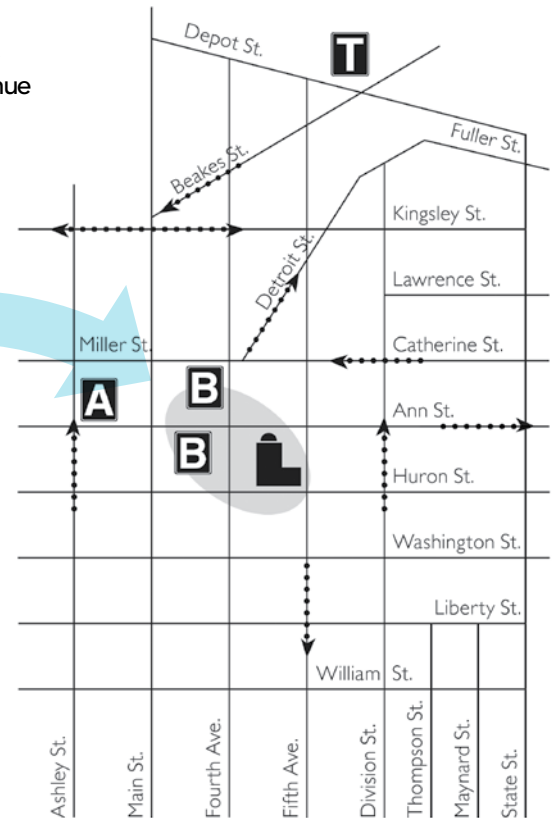
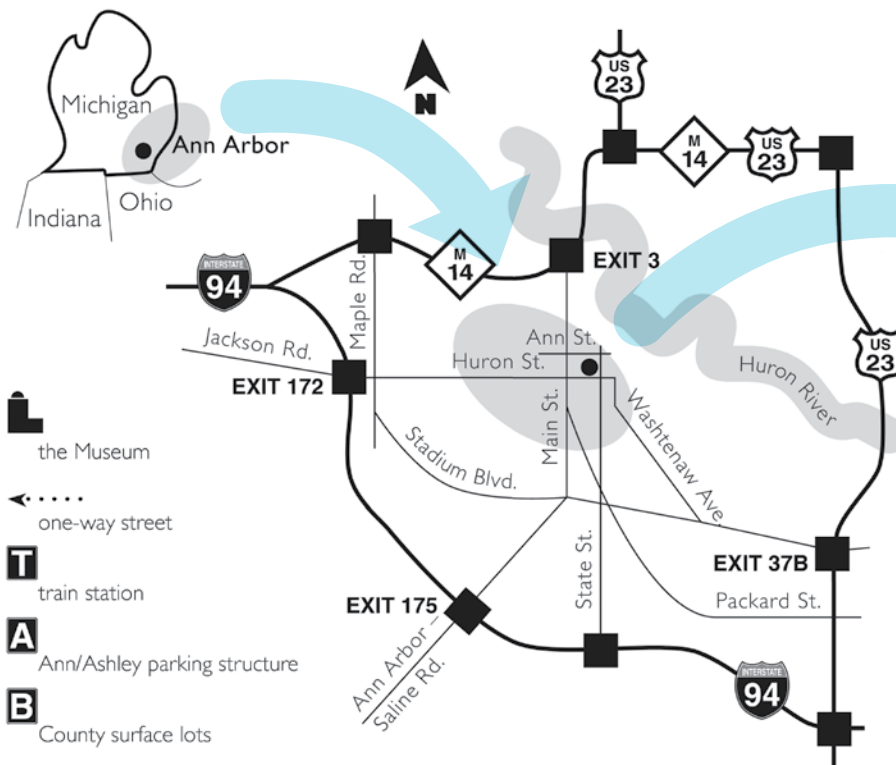
From the NorthEast

- Take I-696 West to I-275 South to m-14 West
- Exit at Downtown Ann Arbor (Exit #3)
- You will be heading south on North Main Street
- The 5th traffic light is Ann Street
- Turn left onto Ann Street
- The Museum entrance is on the right, between Fourth Avenue & Fifth Avenue

Groups may use the curb-cut area in front of the Museum to drop off their scouts and at least one adult before parking their cars.

Camp-In Parking Suggestions*

- Ann/Ashley Parking Structure – \$3 upon entry (Exact change only.)
- County Surface Lots – free (County surface lots fill quickly. Allow extra time and provide drivers with an alternate parking area if you plan to park in one of these lots.)
